#### WHO's New Drugs Protocol

→ World Health Organization (WHO) has divided the drugs into three categories — access, watch and reserve. Commonly used antibiotics will be under the 'access' category; the second line of antibiotics, slightly more potent, have been categorised under "watch" and potent drugs to be used only as a "last resort" fall under the 'reserve' category.
